

## Call for visiting researchers to PRIO, for the period 2022-2026

The <u>Peace Research Institute Oslo (PRIO)</u> is a leading, internationally oriented and interdisciplinary research institution, focusing on topics related to peace and conflict. Our <u>researchers</u> come from a multitude of disciplines, but the social sciences and the humanities dominate. PRIO houses several research centres, including the <u>PRIO Migration Centre</u>, the <u>PRIO Centre on Gender, Peace and Security</u> and the <u>PRIO Centre on Culture and Violent Conflict</u>. We are organized into three research departments: Conditions of Violence and Peace; Dimensions of Security; and Social Dynamics.

Through our joint <u>NORHED II project</u>, <u>Partnership for Peace: Better Higher</u> <u>Education for Resilient Societies</u>, the Peace Research Institute Oslo (PRIO) invites applications for the researcher exchange programme for the period 2022-2026.

We will host up to two guest researchers (PhD or junior faculty) each year for the period 2022-2026. The Norhed-financing will cover travel and accommodation costs, as well as a per diem. The research exchange can last up to two months (60 days).

We will have an annual application deadline. The deadline for the 2022 visiting researchers is **1 December**.

When applying for a guest research placement, please send a short CV of two pages maximum, a letter of motivation, demonstrating how this exchange is relevant to your PhD project or research interests, including tentative activities for your stay. Please also indicate which time during the year are possible/preferable for your exchange.

We have three guiding principles in the participant selection process, namely the quality of candidate; the relevance of the research stay for the candidates' research; and gender balance within each institution and in the researchers' mobility scheme as a whole.
