Access resources to help accelerate COVID-19 research and collaborative evidence generation: the International Severe Acute Respiratory and Emerging Infections Consortium (ISARIC) hosts a portfolio of resources including case report forms and a secure electronic data capture system and repository that standardises and secures global data on COVID-19. Researchers can enter and export data within a centralised, supported database, while retaining ownership and control of their data. High-level aggregate reports of global data are made publicly available.
