Descripción general	Each year the Swiss Confederation awards Government Excellence Scholarships to promote international exchange and research cooperation between Switzerland and over 180 other countries. Recipients are selected by the awarding body, the Federal Commission for Scholarships for Foreign Students (FCS). The Swiss Government Excellence Scholarships are aimed at young researchers from abroad who have completed a master's degree or PhD. <u>Type of scholarships:</u> Postdoctoral Scholarships (12 months): addressed to highly qualified postdoctorate researchers at the beginning of their academic career from all academic fields. The candidate must have a Ph.D. Degree. The Doctorate Diploma must have been obtained after December 31, 2018 and before July 31, 2022. No funding for sabbaticals. Research Fellowship (12 months): To enable selected applicants to undertake research in the realm of their PhD. Targeted to highly qualified postgraduate researchers from all academic fields as well as young medical doctors.

	PhD Scholarships (12-36 months): The scholarship is valid only for full-time PhD studies in Switzerland. It is not valid for mixed PhD programmes (part time in Switzerland and part time in another country). “Cotutelle de these”: PhD students with an ongoing or planned doctoral project that is carried out within the framework of a formalized agreement between two universities (“cotutelle de thèse” cooperation between a Swiss and a foreign university) and under the joint direction of two supervisors are eligible for a 12 month research fellowship only.
